## **CASE INFORMATION**

Statement of Claim filed on or about: August 6, 2019. Scott Ratajczak signed the Submission Agreement: August 6, 2019.

Statement of Answer filed by Respondent on or about: November 4, 2019. Ameriprise Financial Services, LLC signed the Submission Agreement: October 31, 2019.

#### CASE SUMMARY

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant asserted the following causes of action: defamation, prima facie tort, and Form U5 expungement.

Unless specifically admitted in the Statement of Answer, Respondent denied the allegations made in the Statement of Claim and asserted various affirmative defenses.

#### **RELIEF REQUESTED**

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant requested: compensatory damages in an amount to be determined at hearing, but in no event less than \$500,000.00, together with interest thereon from February 29, 2016; punitive damages; expunging the entry on Claimant's Form U5 and replacing said entry with the following explanation: "Terminated without cause"; costs and disbursements, including reasonable attorneys' fees; and for such other and further relief as the Panel deems just, equitable and proper.

In the Statement of Answer, Respondent requested that the Panel deny Claimant's claims in their entirety and that Respondent be awarded its costs, filing and related FINRA fees, attorneys' fees, and such other and further relief as the Panel deems just and warranted.

## OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

The Arbitrators acknowledge that they have each read the pleadings and other materials filed by the parties.

On August 20, 2021, Claimant filed a notice that the parties agreed to a settlement on Claimant's monetary claims and that Claimant will be proceeding with the remaining expungement claim.

The Award in this matter may be executed in counterpart copies.

# **AWARD**

After considering the pleadings, the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the Panel has decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

1. The Panel recommends the expungement of the Reason for Termination and Termination Explanation in Section 3 of Scott Ratajczak's (CRD Number 5034905) Form U5 filed by Ameriprise Financial Services, LLC (CRD Number 6363) on March 11, 2016 and maintained by the Central Registration Depository ("CRD"). The Reason for Termination shall be changed to "Voluntary" and the Termination Explanation should be deleted in its entirety and shall appear blank. This directive shall apply to all references to the Reason for Termination and Termination Explanation.

The Panel recommends expungement based on the defamatory nature of the information. The above recommendations are made with the understanding that the registration records are not automatically amended. Scott Ratajczak must forward a copy of this Award to FINRA's Credentialing, Registration, Education and Disclosure Department for review.

2. Any and all claims for relief not specifically addressed herein, including any requests for punitive damages and attorneys' fees, are denied.
