CASE INFORMATION

Statement of Claim filed on or about: September 19, 2019. Response to the Statements of Answer filed by Claimant on or about: November 26, 2019. Claimant signed the Submission Agreement: October 1, 2019.

Statement of Answer filed by Respondent American Portfolios on or about: November 26, 2019. American Portfolios signed the Submission Agreement: January 4, 2021.

Statement of Answer filed by Respondent Bartolotta on or about: November 19, 2019. Bartolotta signed the Submission Agreement: November 19, 2019.

Statement of Answer filed by Respondent Giancursio on or about: November 26, 2019. Giancursio signed the Submission Agreement: November 27, 2019.

Respondent Four Bridges did not file a Statement of Answer or sign the Submission Agreement.

Respondent Novem did not file a Statement of Answer or sign the Submission Agreement.

CASE SUMMARY

Claimant asserted the following causes of action: lack of training and accountability; lack of proper supervision; inadequate compensation and commissions; harassment; and defamation.

Unless specifically admitted in the Statement of Answer, Respondent American Portfolios denied the allegations made in the Statement of Claim and asserted various affirmative defenses.

Unless specifically admitted in the Statement of Answer, Respondent Bartolotta denied the allegations made in the Statement of Claim.

Unless specifically admitted in the Statement of Answer, Respondent Giancursio denied the allegations made in the Statement of Claim.

RELIEF REQUESTED

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant requested compensatory damages in the amount of \$5,472,585.80; punitive damages in the amount of \$5,000,000.00; attorneys' fees in the amount of \$30,000.00; costs; and interest.

In the Statement of Answer, American Portfolios requested that the Panel dismiss the Statement of Claim, with prejudice, and issue such other and further relief as the Panel deems just, equitable, and proper.

In the Statement of Answer, Respondent Bartolotta requested that the Statement of Claim be denied.

In the Statement of Answer, Respondent Giancursio requested that the Statement of Claim be denied.

OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

The Arbitrators acknowledge that they have each read the pleadings and other materials filed by the parties.

Respondents Four Bridges and Novem are not members or associated persons of FINRA and did not voluntarily submit to arbitration. Therefore, the Panel made no determination with respect to Claimant's claims against Respondents Four Bridges and Novem.

AWARD

After considering the pleadings, and the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the Panel has decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

- 1. Claimant's claims are denied in their entirety.
- 2. Any and all claims for relief not specifically addressed herein, including any requests for punitive damages and attorneys' fees, are denied.

FEES

Pursuant to the Code of Arbitration Procedure ("Code"), the following fees are assessed:

Filing Fees

Member Surcharge =\$ 4,025.00

Member Process Fee =\$ 7.000.00
