## **CASE INFORMATION**

Statement of Claim filed on or about: February 14, 2020.

Claimant signed the Submission Agreement: February 12, 2020.

Statement of Answer filed on or about: May 26, 2020.

Respondent signed the Submission Agreement: February 19, 2020.

## **CASE SUMMARY**

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant asserted that Respondent, after her husband's death, reversed the ACH transactions she made to pay bills and the apology letter she later received was inadequate compensation for the charges incurred and the inconvenience.

Unless specifically admitted in the Statement of Answer, Respondent denied the allegations made in the Statement of Claim and asserted various affirmative defenses.

#### **RELIEF REQUESTED**

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant requested \$116,000.00 in compensatory damages, plus interest and charges incurred.

In the Statement of Answer, Respondent requested that the Panel dismiss the Statement of Claim in its entirety and with prejudice; attorneys' fees and costs, including expert witness fees; and other and further relief as the Panel deems just and proper.

At the hearing, Claimant requested \$175,000.00 in compensatory damages.

## OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

The Arbitrators acknowledge that they have each read the pleadings and other materials filed by the parties.

On July 6, 2021, Respondent filed a request for dismissal of Claimant's case ("Motion to Dismiss") pursuant to Rule 12212(c) of the Code of Arbitration Procedure ("Code") for her failure to comply with an order of the Panel. The same day, Claimant filed correspondence in response to the Motion to Dismiss. Also, in an Order dated the same day, the Panel ruled that the Motion to Dismiss would be heard at the evidentiary hearing.

The Panel heard the Motion to Dismiss at the beginning of the evidentiary hearing and denied the Motion to Dismiss on the record.

At the conclusion of Claimant's case-in-chief, Respondent moved to dismiss Claimant's claims ("Second Motion to Dismiss"), alleging a failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted. Claimant opposed the Second Motion to Dismiss. The Panel denied the Second Motion to Dismiss on the record.

The Award in this matter may be executed in counterpart copies.

## <u>AWARD</u>

After considering the pleadings, the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, and any post-hearing submissions, the Panel has decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

- 1. Claimant's claims are denied in their entirety.
- 2. Any and all claims for relief not specifically addressed herein, including any requests for punitive damages, treble damages, and attorneys' fees, are denied.
