#### **CASE SUMMARY**

In the Amended Statement of Claim, Claimants asserted the following causes of action: breach of fiduciary duty; failure to supervise; and respondeat superior. The causes of action relate to IRA account withdrawals.

Unless specifically admitted in the Statement of Answer, Respondent denied the allegations made in the Statement of Claim and asserted various affirmative defenses.

# RELIEF REQUESTED

In the Amended Statement of Claim, Claimants requested: at least \$493, 687.00 in compensatory damages; consequential damages; interest; costs; and such other relief as the Panel may deem appropriate.

In the Statement of Answer, Respondent requested that the relief request in the Statement of Claim be denied.

### OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

The Arbitrators acknowledge that they have each read the pleadings and other materials filed by the parties.

A Statement of Claim was filed on July 24, 2020. It was not served on Respondent and not considered by the Arbitrator.

The Award in this matter may be executed in counterpart copies.

## **AWARD**

After considering the pleadings, the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, and any post-hearing submissions, the Panel has decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

- 1. Claimants' claims are denied in their entirety.
- 2. Any and all claims for relief not specifically addressed herein, including any requests for consequential damages, interest, costs, and attorneys' fees, are denied.
