CASE SUMMARY

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant asserted a claim alleging that the Form U5 filed by Respondent, as part of registration records maintained by the Central Registration Depository (“CRD”), is defamatory in nature.

Unless specifically admitted in the Statement of Answer, Respondent did not oppose Claimant’s request for expungement.

RELIEF REQUESTED

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant requested expungement of the Form U5 filed by

Respondent and relevant portions of the related Form U4, compensatory damages in the amount of \$1.00, and any other relief the Arbitrator deems just and equitable.

In the Statement of Answer, Respondent did not request any relief.

At the hearing, Claimant withdrew the request for \$1.00 in compensatory damages.

OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

The Arbitrator acknowledges having read the pleadings and other materials filed by the parties.

AWARD

After considering the pleadings, the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, and any post-hearing submissions, the Arbitrator has decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

1. Claimant's request for expungement of the Form U5 filed by Respondent and relevant portions of the related Form U4 from her registration records maintained by the CRD is denied.
2. Any and all claims for relief not specifically addressed herein, including any requests for punitive damages, treble damages, and attorneys' fees, are denied.

FEES

Pursuant to the Code of Arbitration Procedure, the following fees are assessed:

Filing Fees
