CASE SUMMARY

In the Statement of Claim, as amended, Claimant asserted a claim seeking expungement of customer dispute information from registration records maintained by the Central Registration Depository ("CRD").

In the Statement of Answer, Respondent concurred with Claimant's request for expungement and asserted various affirmative defenses.

RELIEF REQUESTED

In the Statement of Claim, as amended, Claimant requested: expungement of Occurrence

Number 2076689; compensatory damages in the amount of \$1.00 from Respondent; and any and all other relief that the Arbitrator deemed just and equitable.

In the Statement of Answer, Respondent requested: expungement of customer dispute information from Claimant's registration records maintained by the CRD; and denial of any and all relief requested against Respondent.

At the beginning of the hearing, Claimant withdrew the request for \$1.00 in damages.

OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

The Arbitrator acknowledges having read the pleadings and other materials filed by the parties.

On or about March 11, 2021, Claimant filed a Motion to Amend the Statement of Claim. No opposition was filed by Respondent. On or about April 2, 2021, the Arbitrator issued an Order that granted the Motion to Amend the Statement of Claim.

The underlying customer participated in the expungement hearing and opposed the expungement request.

AWARD

After considering the pleadings, the testimony and evidence presented at the expungement hearing, and any post-hearing submissions, the Arbitrator has decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

- Claimant's (CRD Number 4931156) request for expungement of Occurrence Number 2076689 from his registration records maintained by the CRD is denied.
- 2. Any and all claims for relief not specifically addressed herein are denied.
