CASE SUMMARY

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant asserted the following causes of action: breach of contract and warranties, promissory estoppel, violation of state securities statutes, breach of fiduciary duty, negligence and gross negligence, misrepresentation/omission and negligent misrepresentation/omission, unjust enrichment, failure to supervise, common law and statutory claims, and vicarious and control person liability. The causes of action related to allegations that

Respondent solicited Claimant to purchase an extremely risky and speculative investment, Franklin Square Investment Corporation II.

Unless specifically admitted in the Statement of Answer, Respondent denied the allegations made in the Statement of Claim and asserted various affirmative defenses.

RELIEF REQUESTED

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant requested compensatory damages of approximately \$226,732.00; statutory damages pursuant to state laws, including rescissionary damages, lost opportunity damages, accrued statutory interest, and attorneys' fees; punitive damages; costs; filing and hearing fees; and other remedies the Panel deems proper and appropriate.

In the Statement of Answer, Respondent requested that Claimant's Statement of Claim be denied with prejudice, together with an award of all reasonable forum costs and expenses, expungement of all references to this matter from Central Registration Depository ("CRD") registration records of Unnamed Party Stephen Kinney ("Kinney"), and other relief as the Panel deems appropriate.

OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

The Arbitrators acknowledge that they have each read the pleadings and other materials filed by the parties.

On September 8, 2021, Claimant filed an Emergency Motion to Request Hearing by Videoconference or to Postpone ("Motion for Videoconference Hearing"). On September 15, 2021, Respondent filed a Response to Claimant's Motion for Videoconference Hearing. On September 16, 2021, Claimant filed a Reply to Respondent's Response to Claimant's Motion for Videoconference Hearing. In an Order dated September 20, 2021, the Panel granted Claimant's request for the hearing to proceed by videoconference.

The Panel considered the request for expungement of Kinney's registration records as part of the in-person, recorded evidentiary hearing conducted in this matter.

The Award in this matter may be executed in counterpart copies.

AWARD

After considering the pleadings, the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, and any post-hearing submissions, the Panel has decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

- 1. Claimant's claims are denied in their entirety.
- Respondent's request for expungement of the above-captioned arbitration (Occurrence Number 2091000) from registration records maintained by the CRD for Unnamed Party Stephen Kinney is denied.

3. Any and all claims for relief not specifically addressed herein, including any requests for punitive damages, treble damages, and attorneys' fees, are denied.
