This matter proceeded pursuant to Rule 13800 of the Code of Arbitration Procedure ("Code").

Respondent John Blaise Ebanietti appeared pro se.

### CASE INFORMATION

Statement of Claim filed on or about: October 26, 2020. RBC Capital Markets LLC signed the Submission Agreement: October 27, 2020.

John Blasie Ebanietti did not file a Statement of Answer or sign the Submission Agreement.

#### CASE SUMMARY

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant asserted the following causes of action: breach of promissory note; unearned Investment Advisor Group ("IAG") program fees; and unjust enrichment.

#### RELIEF REQUESTED

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant requested compensatory damages in the amount of \$35,839.35; cost of filing fees; and any further relief which the Arbitrator deems fair and just.

## OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

The Arbitrator acknowledges having read the pleadings and other materials filed by the parties.

Respondent did not file a properly executed Submission Agreement but is required to submit to arbitration pursuant to the Code and is bound by the determination of the Arbitrator on all issues submitted.

Respondent John Blaise Ebanietti did not file a Statement of Answer. The Arbitrator determined that Respondent John Blaise Ebanietti was served with the Claim Notification letter dated October 29, 2020 by regular mail, as evidenced by the signed signature cards on file/USPS tracking information available online, and the Overdue Notice (including the Statement of Claim) dated December 21, 2020 by regular and certified mail, as evidenced by the signed signature cards on file/USPS tracking information available online. The Arbitrator also determined that Respondent John Blaise Ebanietti was served with the Notification of Arbitrator dated January 13, 2021 by regular and certified mail, as evidenced by the signed signature card on file/USPS tracking information available online.

The Claim Notification letter notified Respondent that FINRA rules require parties to use the online DR Portal on a mandatory basis (except pro se investors) and that failure to register for the DR Portal will prevent the submission of pleadings, selection of arbitrators, and receipt of notification relating to case information and deadlines. Respondent failed to register for the DR Portal.

The Arbitrator determined that Respondent John Blaise Ebanietti is, therefore, bound by the Arbitrator's ruling and determination.

#### **AWARD**

After considering the pleadings, the Arbitrator has decided and determined in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

- 1. Respondent is liable for and shall pay to Claimant the sum of \$35,839.35 in compensatory damages.
- 2. FINRA Dispute Resolution Services shall retain the \$1,450.00 filing fee that Claimant deposited previously.
- 3. Respondent is liable for and shall pay to Claimant \$1,450.00 to reimburse Claimant for the filing fee previously paid to FINRA Dispute Resolution Services.
- 4. Any and all relief not specifically addressed herein, including request for attorneys' fees, if any, are denied.
