Statement of Claim filed on or about: November 19, 2020. Arun Kumar signed the Submission Agreement: November 18, 2020.

Statement of Answer filed by Respondent on or about: February 22, 2021 UBS Financial Services Inc. signed the Submission Agreement: February 22, 2021.

CASE SUMMARY

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant asserted the following causes of action: wrongful termination; and expungement of Form U5 termination entry based on the defamatory nature of the entry in Claimant's Central Registration Depository ("CRD") records.

Unless specifically admitted in the Statement of Answer, Respondent denied the allegations made in the Statement of Claim and asserted various affirmative defenses.

RELIEF REQUESTED

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant requested reformation of his Form U5 due to the defamatory language, compensatory damages of at least \$975,000.00; pre- and post-award interest; attorneys' fees; costs; and such further and additional relief as deemed just, proper, and appropriate.

In the Statement of Answer, Respondent requested that Claimant's claims be dismissed in their entirety.

OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

The Arbitrators acknowledge that they have each read the pleadings and other materials filed by the parties.

On January 21, 2022, the parties filed a Stipulation wherein Claimant withdrew all claims asserted against Respondent with prejudice, except for the claim related to the reformation of Claimant's Form U5. Therefore, the Panel made no determination with respect to any of the other relief requests contained in the Statement of Claim.

The Award in this matter may be executed in counterpart copies.

<u>AWARD</u>

After considering the pleadings, the testimony and evidence presented at the expungement hearing, and any post-hearing submissions, the Panel has decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

The Panel recommends the expungement of the Termination Explanation in Section 3 of Claimant Arun Kumar's (CRD Number 4577470) Form U5 filed by Respondent UBS Financial Services, Inc. (CRD Number 8174) on May 22, 2020 and maintained by the CRD. The Reason for Termination shall remain the same. The Termination Explanation shall be replaced with the following language: "Terminated without cause." This directive shall apply to all references to the Termination Explanation.

The Panel further recommends the expungement of all references to Occurrence Number 2074731 maintained by the CRD for Claimant Arun Kumar. Any "Yes" answers should be changed to "No," as applicable.

The Panel recommends expungement based on the defamatory nature of the information. The above recommendations are made with the understanding that the registration records are not automatically amended. Claimant Arun Kumar must forward a copy of this Award to FINRA's Credentialing, Registration, Education and Disclosure Department for review.
