Robert T. Wong did not file a Statement of Answer or sign the Submission Agreement.

#### CASE SUMMARY

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant asserted the following causes of action: breach of contract (employment agreement).

## **RELIEF REQUESTED**

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant requested damages in the amount of \$33,333.00; attorneys' fees and costs; pre-award and post-award interest; and any further relief the Panel may deem just and proper.

## OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

The Arbitrator acknowledges having read the pleadings and other materials filed by the parties.

Respondent did not file a properly executed Submission Agreement but is required to submit to arbitration pursuant to the Code of Arbitration Procedure ("Code") and is bound by the determination of the Arbitrator on all issues submitted.

The Arbitrator determined that Respondent was served with the Claim Notification letter dated December 8, 2020 by regular mail and the Overdue Notice (including the Statement of Claim) dated January 28, 2021 by regular and certified mail, as evidenced by the signed signature cards on file/USPS tracking information available online. The Arbitrator also determined that Respondent was served with the Notification of Arbitrator dated February 23, 2021 by regular mail.

The Claim Notification letter notified Respondent Robert T. Wong that FINRA rules require parties to use the online DR Portal on a mandatory basis (except pro se investors) and that failure to register for the DR Portal will prevent the submission of pleadings, selection of arbitrators, and receipt of notification relating to case information and deadlines. Respondent Robert T. Wong failed to register for the DR Portal.

Respondent Robert T. Wong did not appear at the evidentiary hearing. Upon review of the file, the Arbitrator determined that Respondent Robert T. Wong received due notice of the hearing and that arbitration of the matter would proceed without Respondent Robert T. Wong present, in accordance with the Code.

The Arbitrator determined that Respondent Robert T. Wong is, therefore, bound by the Arbitrator's ruling and determination.

#### **AWARD**

After considering the pleadings, the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the Arbitrator has decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

- 1. Respondent is liable for and shall pay to Claimant the sum of \$33,333.00 in compensatory damages.
- 2. Respondent is liable for and shall pay to Claimant interest on the above-stated sum at the rate of 9% per annum from April 1, 2020 through and including the date the award is paid in full.
- 3. Respondent is liable for and shall pay to Claimant the sum of \$1,000.00 in costs.
- 4. Respondent is liable for and shall pay to Claimant the sum of \$15,090.90 in attorneys' fees pursuant to terms of the employment agreement.
- 5. Any and all claims for relief not specifically addressed herein are denied.
