RELIEF REQUESTED

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant requested expungement of the Form U5 filed by Respondent and relevant portions of the related Form U4, \$1.00 in compensatory damages, and any other relief as the Arbitrator deems just and equitable.

In the Statement of Answer, Respondent requested that Claimant's claims be denied, that all costs and forum fees be assessed against Claimant, and any other relief the Arbitrator deems just and proper.

At the hearing, Claimant withdrew the request for \$1.00 in compensatory damages.

The Arbitrator acknowledges having read the pleadings and other materials filed by the parties.

AWARD
