#### **RELIEF REQUESTED**

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant requested expungement of the November 26, 2019, termination disclosure (Occurrence Number 2056463) on her Central Registration Depository ("CRD") registration records.

In the Statement of Answer, Respondent did not set forth a specific relief request.

### OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

The Arbitrators acknowledge that they have each read the pleadings and other materials filed by the parties.

The Award in this matter may be executed in counterpart copies.

### **AWARD**

After considering the pleadings, the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the Panel has decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

The Panel recommends the expungement of the Reason for Termination and Termination Explanation in Section 3 of Randi Speedling's (CRD Number 4703534) Form U5 filed by Wells Fargo Clearing Services, LLC (CRD Number 19616) on December 18, 2019 and maintained by the Central Registration Depository ("CRD"). The Reason for Termination shall be changed to "Voluntary", and the Termination Explanation should be deleted in its entirety and shall appear blank. This directive shall apply to all references to the Reason for Termination and Termination Explanation.

The Panel further recommends the expungement of all references to Occurrence Numbers 2056463 and 2056464 maintained by the CRD for Randi Speedling. Any "Yes" answers should be changed to "No," as applicable.

The Panel recommends expungement based on the defamatory nature of the information. The above recommendations are made with the understanding that the registration records are not automatically amended. Randi Speedling must forward a copy of this Award to FINRA's Credentialing, Registration, Education and Disclosure Department for review.
