CASE SUMMARY

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant asserted a claim seeking expungement of customer dispute information from registration records maintained by the Central Registration Depository ("CRD").

In the Statement of Answer, Respondent did not oppose Claimant's request for expungement.

RELIEF REQUESTED

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant requested expungement of Occurrence Number 1977417 and any and all other relief that the Arbitrator deems just and equitable.

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In the Statement of Answer, Respondent requested that the Arbitrator deny Claimant's request for any and all other relief against Respondent and that all FINRA filing fees, hearing fees, etc. be assessed against Claimant.

OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

The Arbitrator acknowledges having read the pleadings and other materials filed by the parties.

On October 8, 2021, the parties stipulated to have this matter heard by an arbitration panel consisting of one arbitrator pursuant to Rule 13401(c) of the Code of Arbitration Procedure ("Code").

The Arbitrator conducted a recorded, telephonic hearing on March 7, 2022, so the parties could present oral argument and evidence on Claimant's request for expungement.

Respondent did not participate in the expungement hearing.

The customer related to Occurrence Number 1977417 participated in the expungement hearing and opposed the expungement request.

AWARD

After considering the pleadings, the testimony and evidence presented at the expungement hearing, and any post-hearing submissions, the Arbitrator has decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

- 1. Claimant's request for expungement of Occurrence Number 1977417 from registration records maintained by the CRD is denied.
- 2. Any and all claims for relief not specifically addressed herein are denied.
